### VIBRANT Resources

- ➔ 50% subsidy on MMPC-*Live* Phenotyping services
- ➔ Travel awards to scientific meetings or courses/ training activities
- ➔ Access to MMPC-*Live* experts to discuss academic research and/or experimental design
- ➔ Grant application review

#### VIBRANT Investigator eligibility criteria:

New investigator as defined by the NIH at an institution that does not have an NIDDK-funded MMPC-*Live* program or animal physiology/ metabolic phenotyping core that provides similar services
